**BGMU'S WATER TREATMENT PLANT RIBBON CUTTING  
16 CHESTNUT STREET

The Bowling Green Area Chamber of Commerce will conduct a ribbon cutting at Bowling Green Municipal Utilities' Water Treatment Plant, 16 Chestnut Street on Thursday, January 18, 2007 at 2:00 p.m. We will be "Connecting Bowling Green" by turning the switch on to the new raw water intake pumps.

Bowling Green Municipal Utilities is continually working to meet the ever-growing needs of Bowling Green and Warren County. The current upgraded system provides up to 30 million gallons of drinking water per day, where the old system treated 22.5 million gallons of water per day. The completed plant improvements also allow operators and chemists to better monitor the treatment process and aid in plant security.

Bowling Green Municipal Utilities is always planning for the future to meet the growing needs of Bowling Green and Warren County.
