(Bowling Green, Ky.) Bowling Green Municipal Utilities would like to welcome Todd Alcott to its Board of Directors. Alcott, Mayor of Bowling Green, replaced former Mayor Bruce Wilkerson at the end of his term.

Mayor Alcott is a Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) teacher at Warren East High School. He served as Lieutenant Colonel in the U.S. Air Force over 21.5 years and retired in 2016. Alcott retired from the Pentagon on the Air Staff as the Chief of Resilience for the Air Force. He also served four combat support command tours and was selected as a Squadron Commander 3 times: Osan Air Base, Manass Air Base and Ramstein Air Base. He also served as the Chief of Air Force lodging for the Air Force and was the Chief of Personnel for the joint force Operation Security & Cooperation in Baghdad, Iraq at the U.S. Embassy.

Raised on a small farm in Warren County, Alcott is a graduate of Warren Central High School and Western Kentucky University. He and his family returned to Bowling Green in 2016 following his retirement. His wife, Debra, is a teacher at Alvaton Elementary. They have one son, Jacob, who currently works for a software company in Chicago.
